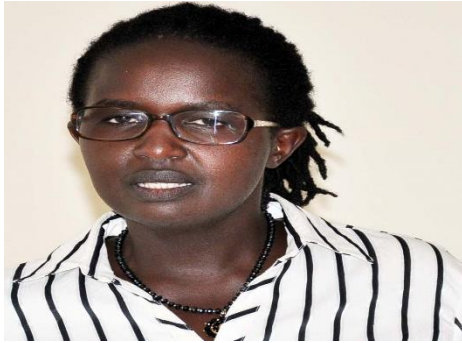

1. **Dr Marguerite MUKANGANGO**

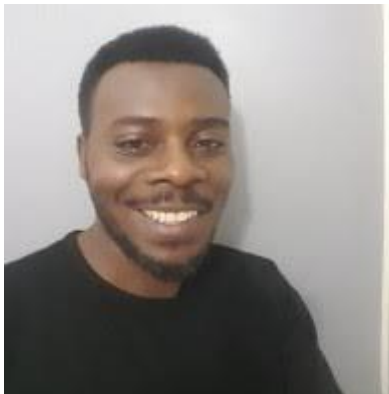
